



The Chatfield Fish & Game Club Scholarship 2024

The following guidelines apply:

- One scholarship awarded per senior high school applicant, per year. Two \$500 scholarships will be available.
- Scholarship is valid within one year from the date issued.
- Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited vocational school, college or university earning credits towards a two- or four-year degree, graduate degree, or law school degree.
- Preference for applicants who have advanced general knowledge of the hunter safety program and are current Chatfield Fish and Game Club members.
- Preference for applicants who have a Hunter Safety Certificate and are a current member of a high school shooting team.
- Term GPA of a "C" or better.
- The award will be adjusted based on full-time/part-time status.
- Payment will be issued after review of the transcript from the school attended (school and student name <u>must</u> be listed on transcript).
- Application must be typed. A handwritten application will not be accepted.
- Scholarship is not guaranteed. Final decisions will be made by the Chatfield Fish and Game Board Members.
- Application must be received by 11:59 p.m. on April 10, 2024. A late application will not be accepted.
